

What is Barbering?

Barbering is the practice of shaving or trimming the beard, cutting the hair, and giving facial and scalp massages with oils, creams, lotions, or other preparations, either by hand or using mechanical appliances. Barbers are also trained in singeing, shampooing, arranging, dressing, cutting, waving, chemical waving, hair relaxing, or dyeing the hair or applying hair tonics and in applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays, or lotion to the scalp, face, or neck.

How is a Barber Different from a Cosmetologist?

Cosmetologists as well as barbers may perform most common services, listed above. However, some services, such as shaving, can only be performed by barbers.

- Barber Crossover 200 hours
- Barber Instructor 600 hours
- Barber Refresher 200 hours

Admission Requirements

- High School GED or its equivalency.
- Be not less than 17 years of age at the time of state board examination and have completed the required hours.
- Valid driver's license ID, passport, or other ID issued by the Government. Social Security number.

Teaching Methods

Clock hour education will be provided to meet all tasks necessary for state board licensure, graduation of the program, and entry level employment. Instruction techniques include demonstrations, student participation, audio/video resources, printed materials, hands on activities, lesson plans, and reading. Instructors supervise students as they practice their operations on a live model or mannequin.

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Description

The Barber Course is to train students in the proper practice of Barbering services. Men's and women's hair services, health and safety, disinfection and sanitation, life skills, and preparation for licensure and employment. The Barber Course consists of 1,000 clock hours of Practical Operations and Technical Instruction covering 600 hours of Hair Dressing, 200 hours of Health & Safety, and 200 hours of Shaving. The instructions will cover the art and science of barbering from techniques in hair and shaving to business skills in barbering. This program of study satisfies the requirements of Section 7362.5(a) states: "A course in barbering or cosmetology established by a school shall consist of not less than 1,000 hours of practical and technical instruction in the practice of barbering or cosmetology..."
